Best hotels in Santorini

The fashionista's Greek island choice is spoilt for suave suntrap hotels and there are plenty of newcomers dialling up the luxury with even-swankier suites, villas and cave houses. Which designer oasis does it for you?

2. Andronis Arcadia

The vibe at [Andronis Arcadia](#) is a cream-and-wicker beach club, with a sprinkle of neighbouring Mykonos's all-week party scene. Rooms are spacious, with private plunge pools; potent cocktails are served from a swim-up bar; and a filling, brunchy breakfast is served until 11am. This hotel is in tourist-magnet Oia (loved for its sunsets) but on the flatter, quieter side of town, rather than Santorini's iconic caldera (a vertiginous volcano rim). The pool and room terraces all face the sunset and the guests taking in these breathtaking views are young, tanned, and not shy about downing a Santorini Spritz before midday. Dine at its sushi bar, Oishii, which is a novelty on this island's largely Greek dining scene, while Opson's Ancient Greek feast is a classics lesson in the form of a banquet.
